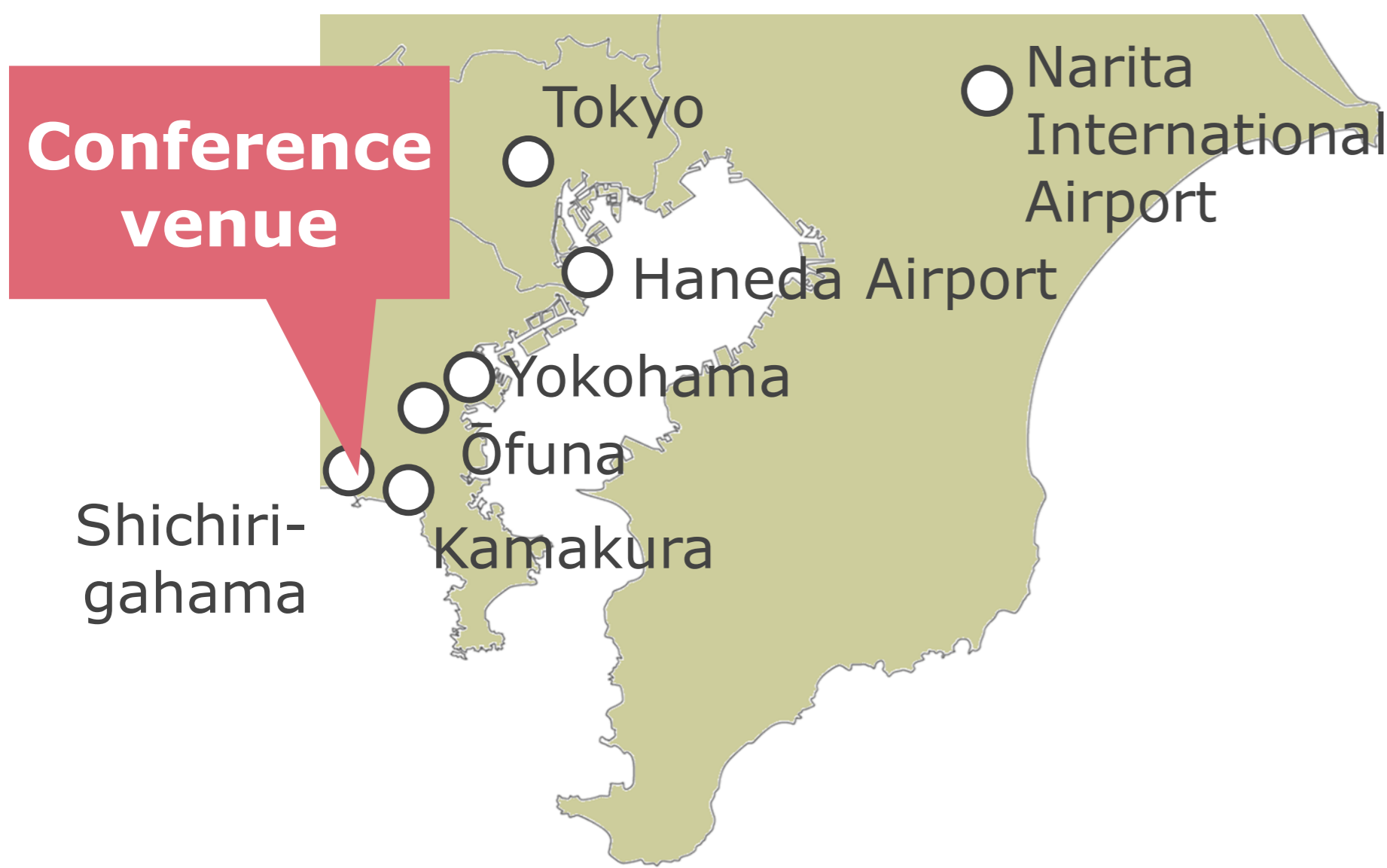


## Location

- There are a number of shrines and temples including Kotokuin with a giant Buddha statue.



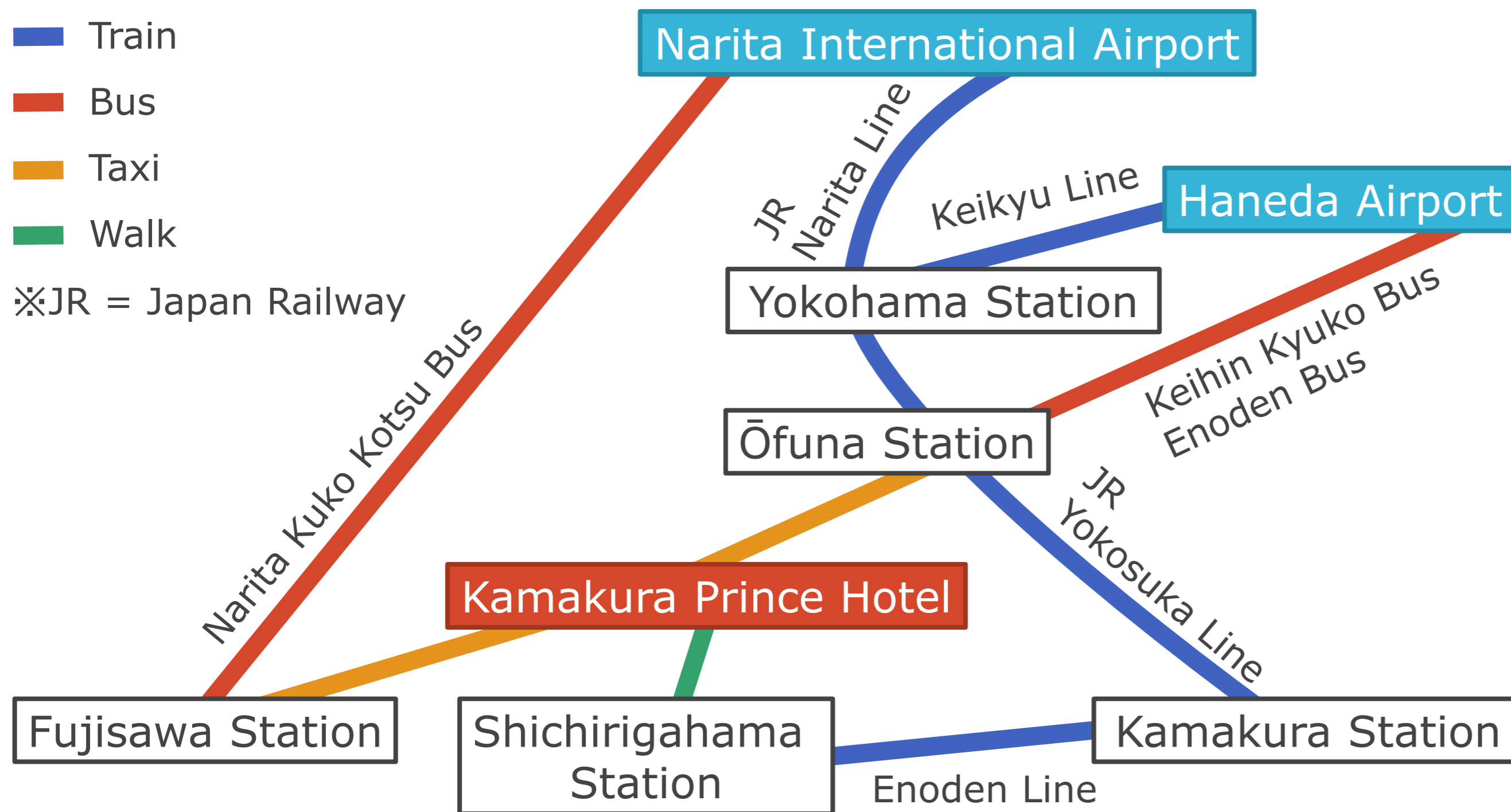
### Conference venue

## Overview of transportation



There are two ways to reach the conference venue:

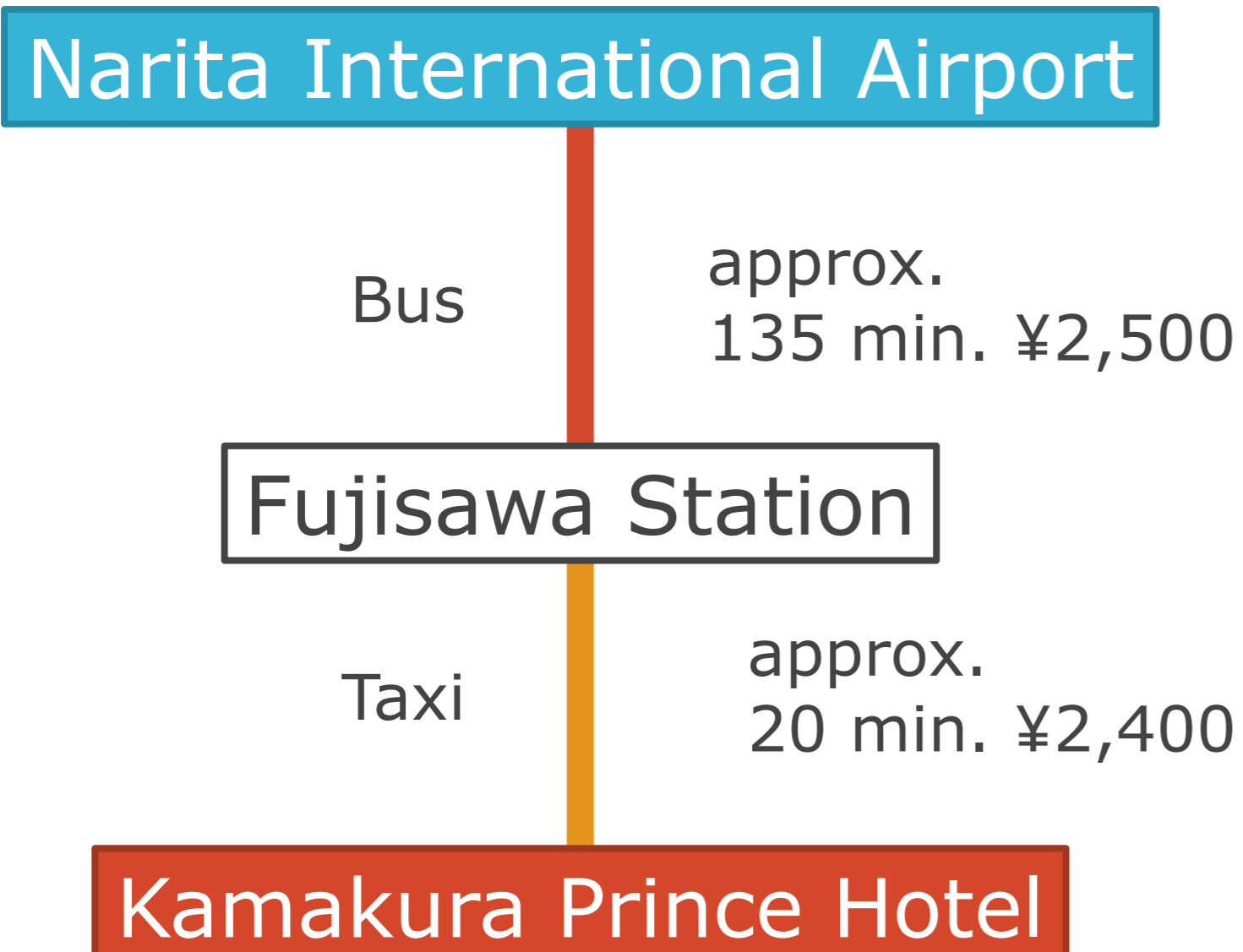
If you want to use train, please head to the **Kamakura** station first. Then change to the local Enoden line to the **Shichirigahama** station.

If you want to use bus & taxi, please take a coach to **Ofuna** or **Fujisawa**. Then take a taxi to Kamakura Prince Hotel.

## By Bus & Taxi

### From Narita International Airport

※Taxi fare may vary depending on traffic conditions.

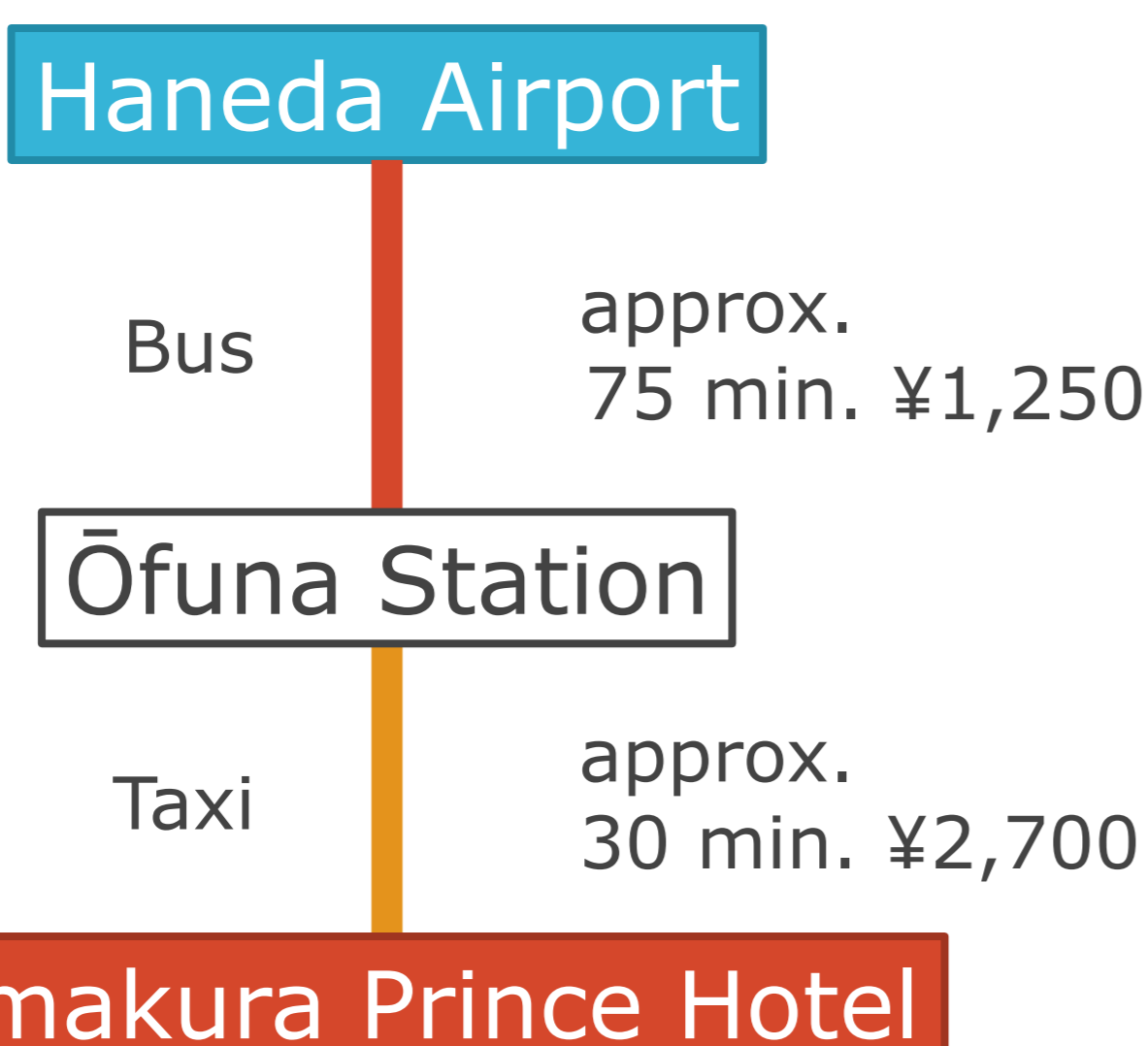


From Narita international airport, take the bus operated by Narita Kuko Kotsu to the **Fujisawa** station. It will take approx. 135 minutes and cost ¥2,500.

Then please take a taxi to Kamakura Prince hotel. It will take approx. 20 minutes and cost approx. ¥2,400.

### From Haneda Airport



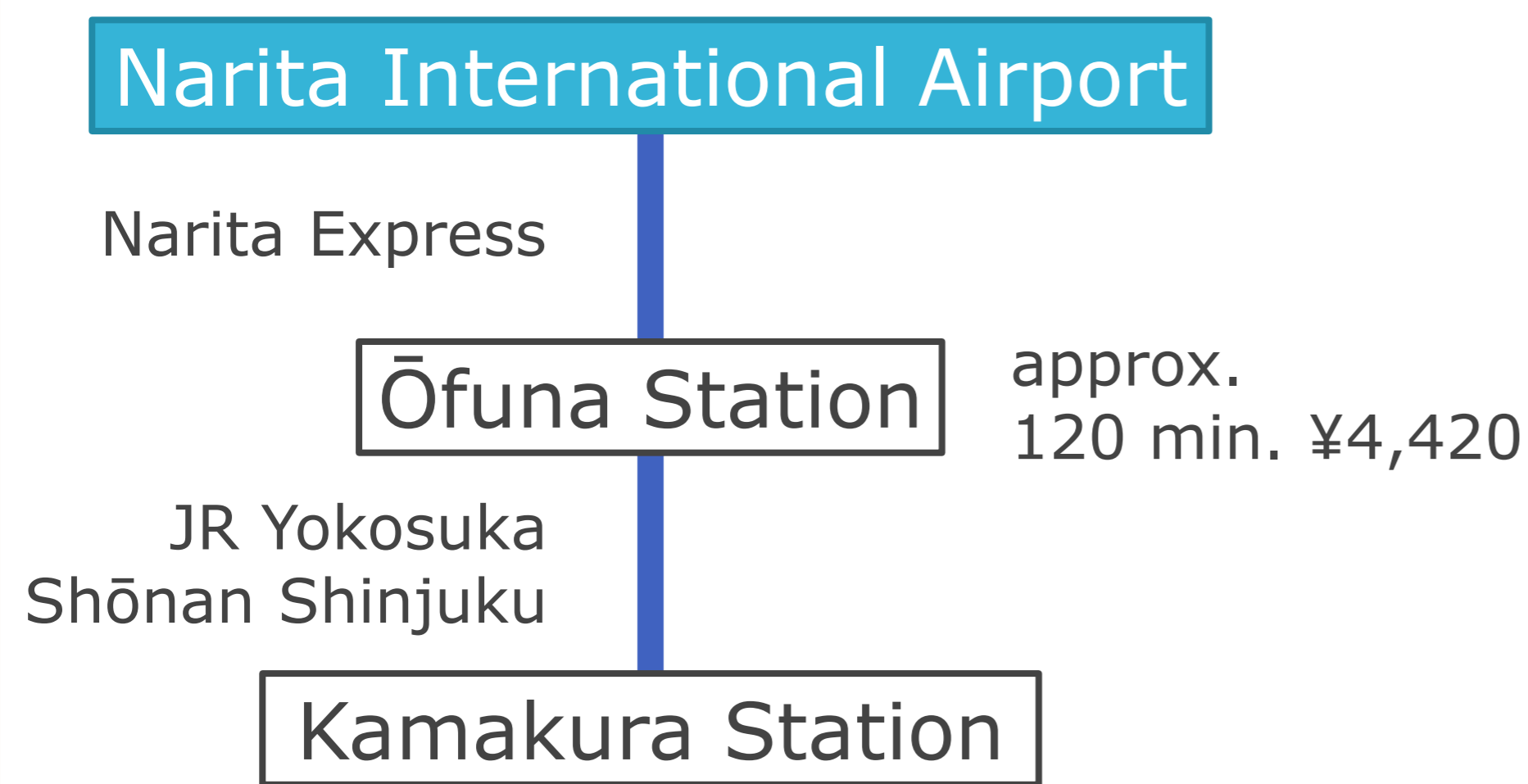
From Haneda airport, take the bus bound for Fujisawa operated by Keihin Kyuko or Enoden, and get off at the **Ofuna** station. It takes 75 minutes and costs ¥1,250.

Then take a taxi to Kamakura Prince hotel. It takes about 30 minutes and costs ¥2,700.

## By Train

### From Narita International Airport to Kamakura



Take the Limited Express "**Narita Express (N'EX)**" on the JR Narita line platform to **Ōfuna** station. Then change to the train bound for Zushi, Yokosuka or Kurihama, and get off at **Kamakura** station.

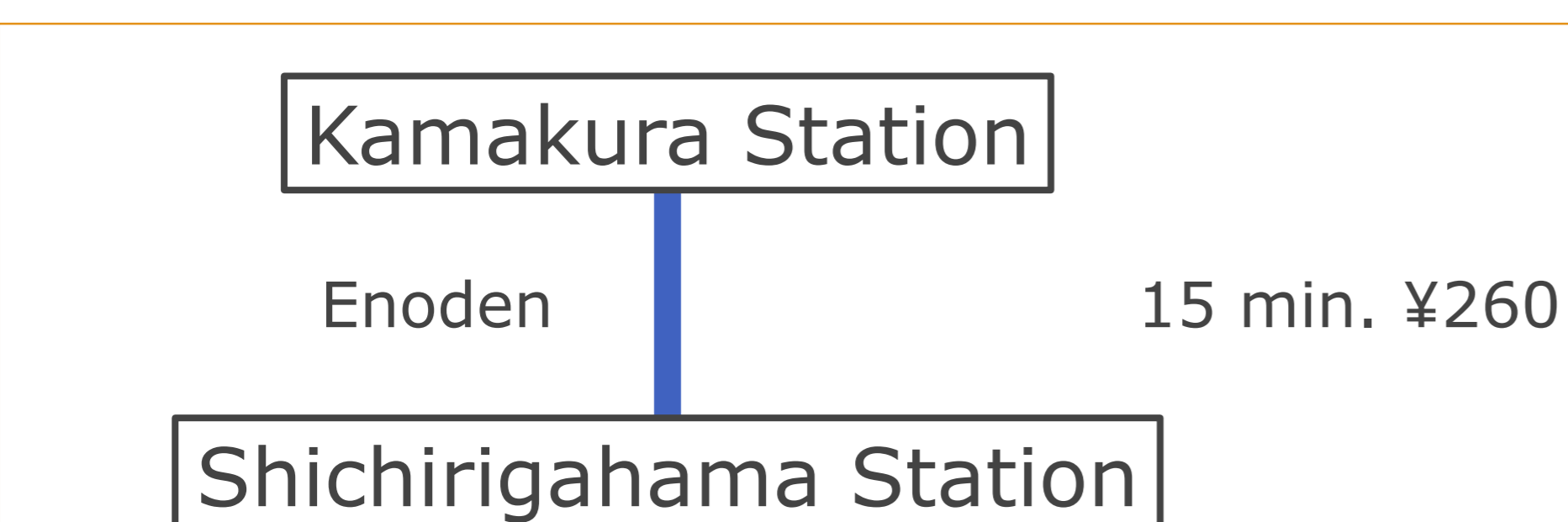
If you want to spare money, take the rapid train on the same line from Narita Airport to Kamakura station. It will take approx. 160 minutes and cost ¥2,270.

### From Haneda Airport to Kamakura



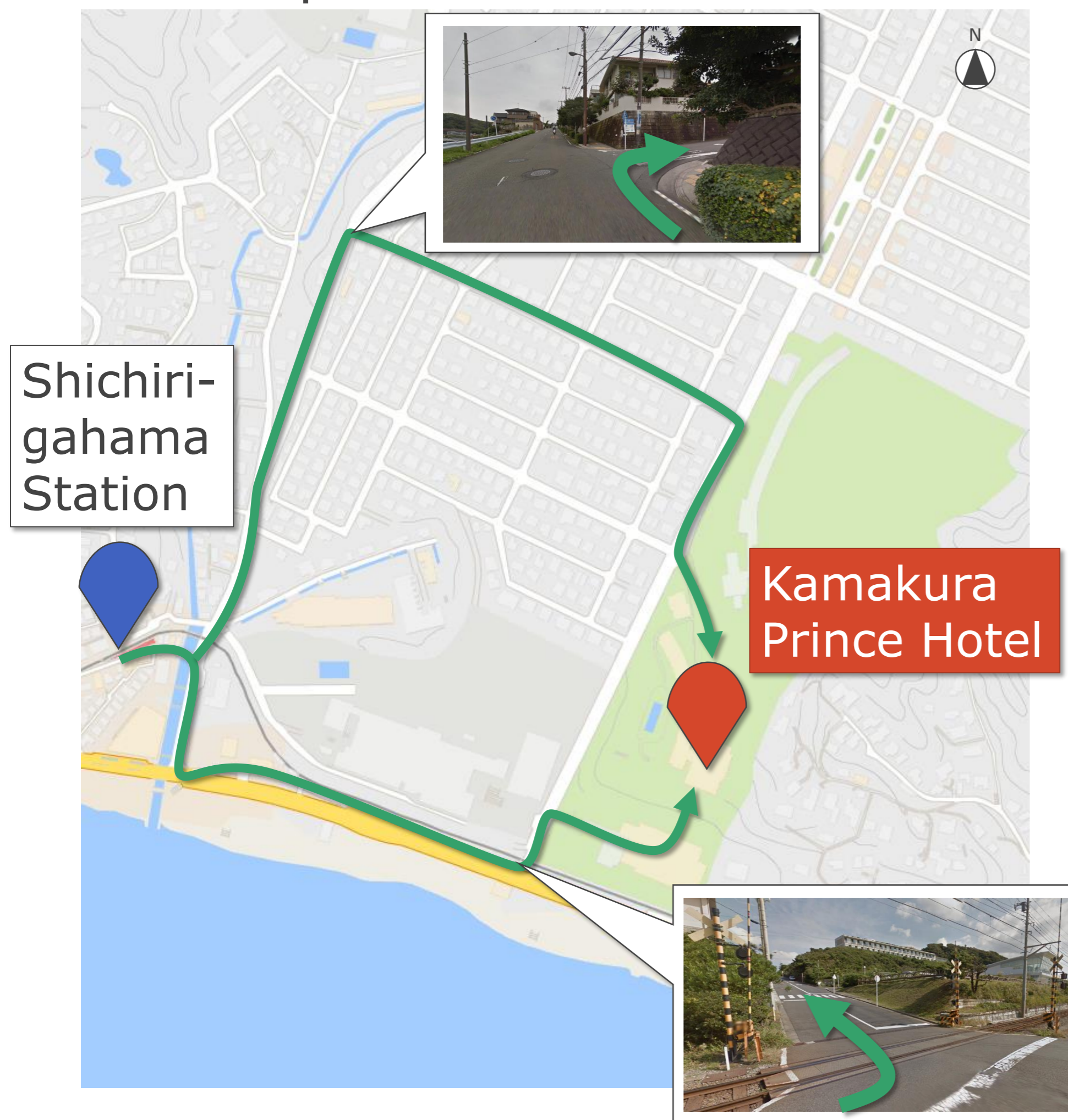
Take Keikyu line train to **Yokohama** station. Then change to the JR Yokosuka line or JR Shōnan Shinjuku line train bound for Zushi, Yokosuka or Kurihama, and get off at **Kamakura** station.

### From Kamakura to the conference venue



Take the **Enoden** line half-train/half-streetcar bound for Fujisawa, and get off at Shichirigahama station.

#### Route map near the conference venue



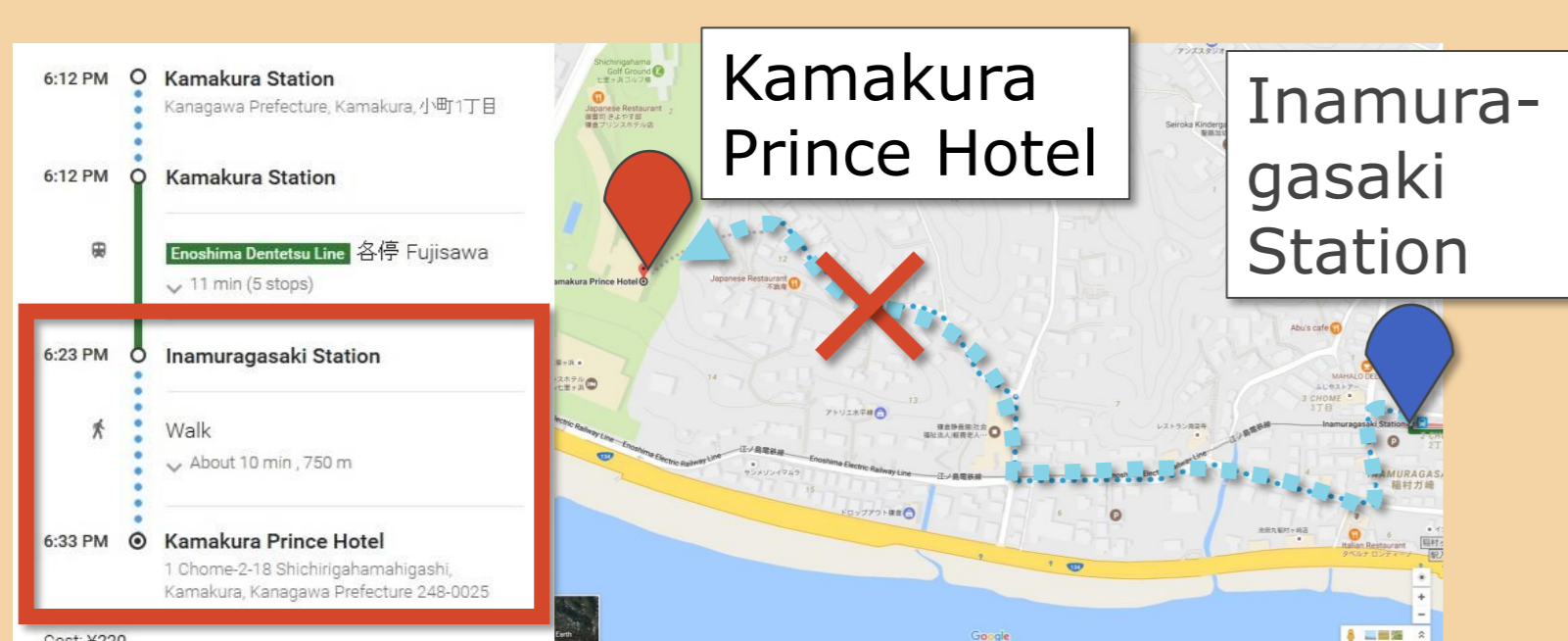
It takes 10 minutes on foot from Shichirigahama station. When you walk, please check the route map carefully not to miss the way.

There is a free shuttle bus between Shichirigahama station and Kamakura Prince Hotel.

### Caution!! Do NOT take the way suggested by Google Map.



Google map shows the way from Inamuragasaki station. But the route indicated by Google Map is very complex and gives no information sign. Therefore, we recommend you to get off at Shichirigahama station instead of Inamuragasaki station.
